



REACH DECLARATION

With this Declaration, we want to inform the Corporación Empresarial Altra commitment to comply with the REACH Regulation (EC 1907/2006). Corporación Empresarial Altra policy is to be fully compliant with the REACH legislation and to work closely with suppliers and customers. This declaration is part of our policy of keeping our customers fully informed about our REACH commitment.

Corporación Empresarial Altra is considered as "downstream user" as far as the REACH document, Art 3, Nº 13; hence, it is not obligated to register our products. As "downstream user", we must guarantee, within the established deadline, we only use registered substances.

In order to guarantee compliance with REACH Regulation, Corporación Empresarial Altra has requested information from its suppliers to know the substances in the products that they supply us.

The products that we supply are non-chemical products and under normal and reasonable use, they will not release harmful substance.

Corporación Empresarial Altra declares, based on the information provided to date by our suppliers, that substances / preparations used in the business units dedicated to the design and manufacturing of control equipment for the air conditioning sector comply with REACH requirements. In the case of chemicals substances, designated by European Chemical Agency (ECHA) as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), are contained in our final products in concentration above 0,1% (w/w), this information will be properly communicated to our customers.

Corporación Empresarial Altra will continue to monitor the REACH regulation and advice of any changes. More information about these kind of substances in ECHA website, appended on the following link:
